Fair Exhibit Requirements

1. Open to all 4-H clubs and individuals in the county.
2. Container to be provided by the exhibitor. Container should complement the area it is to be used in.
3. Containers should be moveable. Example; box, barrel, wheelbarrow, watering can.
4. Placement of containers is on a first come, first serve basis. Fair Office to be notified of location of container by noon on Monday of the fair.
5. Planters to be in place by 8 a.m., Monday of the fair and remain in place until 8 a.m. on Sunday. Display may be set up as early as Saturday prior to fair after 6:00 p.m.
6. Division 7501 - Container using incorporation of fair theme (if there is a fair theme). Division 7502 - Container not incorporating fair theme (if there is a fair theme).
7. Award winners will be announced during Opening Ceremonies.

Judging Criteria:

1. Container compatible to location placed.
2. Flowers and arrangements fresh, healthy, and complimentary to container and location.
3. Overall appearance of entry.

DIVISION 7501 – CONTAINER INCORPORATING FAIR/PROJECT

Container incorporating fair or project area theme.

Awards: 1st=\$20; 2nd=\$15; 3rd=\$10

Class 01 – 4-H Club or group

Class 02 – Individual

DIVISION 7502 – CONTAINER NOT INCORPORATION FAIR/PROJECT

Container not incorporating fair or project area theme

Awards: 1st=\$20; 2nd=\$15; 3rd=\$10

Class 04 – 4-H Club or group

Class 05 – Individual

DIVISION 7503 – RECYCLED BEAUTIFY THE FAIRGROUND DISPLAY

Display or container previously exhibited at the fair that was awarded a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place award that has been recycled in some manner.

Awards: 1st=\$20; 2nd=\$15; 3rd=\$10
