Project Requirements

1. Youth between 4-H ages of 5-8 can enter in the fair as Clover Sprouts. Youth 8 years old as of Jan. 1 of the current year will be classified as Senior Clover Sprouts.
2. No live livestock or animals may be exhibited by 5-7 year olds. Youth 8 years old as of January 1 will be classified as a Senior Clover Sprout. See Rule #10.
3. No premiums awarded. Participation ribbons will be awarded.
4. Children with multiple still exhibit projects will be judged by 1 person in a very relaxed interview. All projects will be judged at this time.
5. Parents are encouraged to be supportive; however, the interview is with the child only.
6. Projects limited to three (3) in still exhibit barn.
7. Due to lack of display space, please no larger than a half sheet of poster board for posters.
8. Collections exhibited should be by photograph exhibit only.
9. Any project record books or posters should be brought to your interview.
10. Projects restricted to still exhibits that can be displayed in the still exhibit building, EXCEPT Senior Clover Sprouts may exhibit their own livestock.
 - a. Senior Clover Sprouts not limited to number of Clover Sprout livestock classes they participate in, and Clover Sprout livestock classes do not count towards total number of projects exhibited in still exhibit barn.
 - b. Senior Clover Sprouts must use their own livestock (market poultry, market rabbits, market sheep, swine, market beef, market veal, market goats). There will be a Senior Clover Sprout Showmanship Class in each livestock project area and exhibitors may use their own livestock or borrow livestock.
 - c. Livestock shown in Senior Clover Sprout Market classes must follow rules of each species to allow that animal to show and sell at auction.
 - d. Senior Clover Sprouts must be accompanied in the livestock exhibition area, make up ring and show ring by a teen exhibitor, 4-H leader or parent.
 - e. Must sign up for Clover Sprouts online in each project area of anticipated participation (Except Still Exhibit Barn Projects which is Division 6001, Class 10). See each project guideline for project requirements, show schedule, check in times and project exhibition time.
 - f. Sign up under Clover Sprouts for all Clover Sprout project areas, including Senior Clover Sprout classes. Senior Clover Spouts not limited to number of Senior Clover Sprout classes they show, but each class must be designated on online entry.
 - g. Senior Clover Sprout Market animals are eligible for sale on auction. These animals will sell at end of each designated specie sale.

h. See horse and dog project areas for specific Clover Sprout exhibit guidelines.
