Figure Eight Rules & Guidelines

Saturday, July 22, 2017 7:00 p.m. sharp

Check in time is 4:00pm – 6:00pm

Each driver has an obligation to READ THESE RULES!

- In the interest of safety, drivers and mechanics are subject to and must obey the following rules and regulations.
- Each driver must fill out an entry form. **ONLY ONE ENTRY PER PERSON.**
- All drivers must supply their own cars.
- **IF YOUR CAR DOES NOT PASS INSPECTION, THERE WILL BE NO RE-ENTRY! NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- All drivers and/or pit persons under 18 years of age must have a notarized release signed by his or her parent or guardian.
- **Nobody under the age of 14 can be in the pit area. NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
- St. Clair County Agricultural Society reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
- Only persons who sign the waiver and release form will be permitted in the pit area or on the track.
- **NO POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. ANY DRIVER OR PIT PERSON UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WILL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED AND REMOVED FROM THE GROUNDS.**
- Any driver or crewmember disobeying the rules will cause his or her car to be disqualified. Drivers are responsible for the actions of their crewmembers.
- The promoter, track owner or St. Clair County Agricultural Society will not be held responsible for any cars, parts or personal property before, during and after the event.
- Towing and transporting cars to and from race locations must meet highway safety codes (including proper light controls, safety chains, tow bars, towing trailers, etc.).

TYPE OF CAR (SEDANS ONLY) AND PREPARATION

1. Any American made hardtop automobile with a 116" wheelbase or under including front-wheel drive. No taxis, pick-ups or 4 X 4's.
2. Remove the following **before** arriving: all glass, windshield, side & rear windows, head and tail lights. **ROLLING WINDOWS DOWN IS NOT PERMITTED.**
3. Chrome molding strips, the bottom portion of rear seats carpet and interior fabric to be removed.
4. Any sharp protruding fins or dangerous objects (smash down or cut off).
5. Weld solid or chained down engine mounts are recommended.
6. Radiators must remain in original position or be taken off. Comparable replacement radiators are permitted, but only if they are secured inside engine compartment.
7. Stock gas tanks must be removed and put inside the car. Tank must be a boat tank or racing cell. Tank must be securely mounted. No bungee cords for mounting tank.
8. Bumpers maybe be reinforced. Homemade bumpers are allowed. Any bumper may not have sharp or protruding points. If bumpers are found to be a safety hazard they will be cut.
9. Roll bars are permitted in drivers' compartment. You may have a radiator protector mounted in front of the core support. This may not be wider than the front fenders and may have bars that extend back onto the frame.
10. All doors and trunk must be fastened shut by wire, straps, chains, or welded for the drivers' safety.
11. It is mandatory that an opening be cut in the hood over the carburetor, approximately 12" or larger in diameter. A metal strap or chain from roof down to cowl is required.
12. Batteries must be mounted inside of cars. Batteries must be securely mounted to floor or cage. No bungees for mounting battery.
