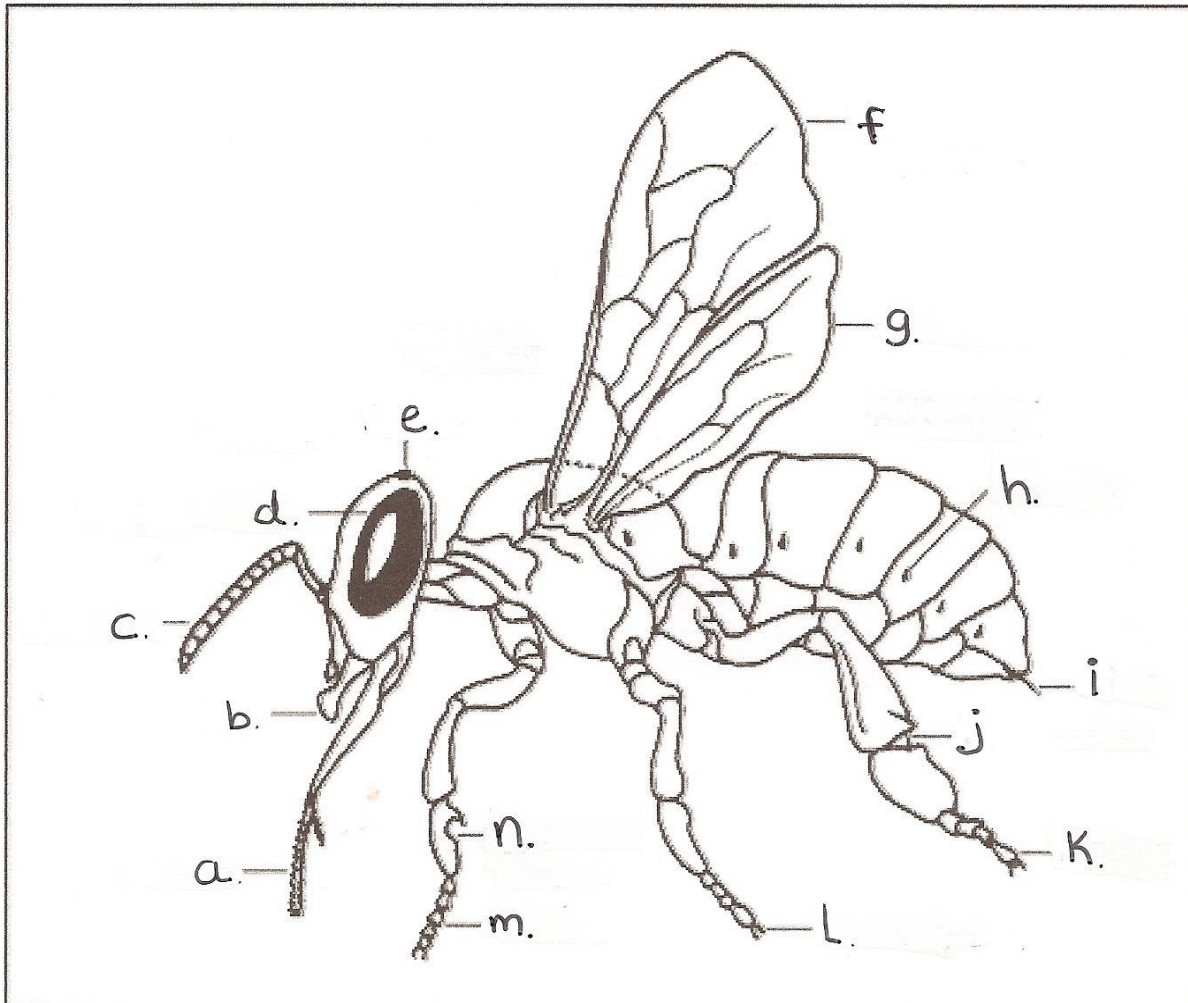

Project Record Book Requirements

- A project record book must be completed in order to show any product of the hive.
- Project record book should be presented in a white one inch binder.
- Exhibitor must include a picture of the hive used for their project on the cover of the project record book.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their project record book, additional labeled pictures of the hive and bees may be included at the end of the book.
- Project record book must include all hive observation sheets, all sheets must be signed by an adult supervisor.
- Observation sheets completed after July 1 must be presented with the exhibited product.
- The project requires that the exhibitor visits at least one hive other than their home hive. An observation sheet must be filled out with the date and location of that hive visit.
- Project record books are due to the Fair office no later than July 1st.

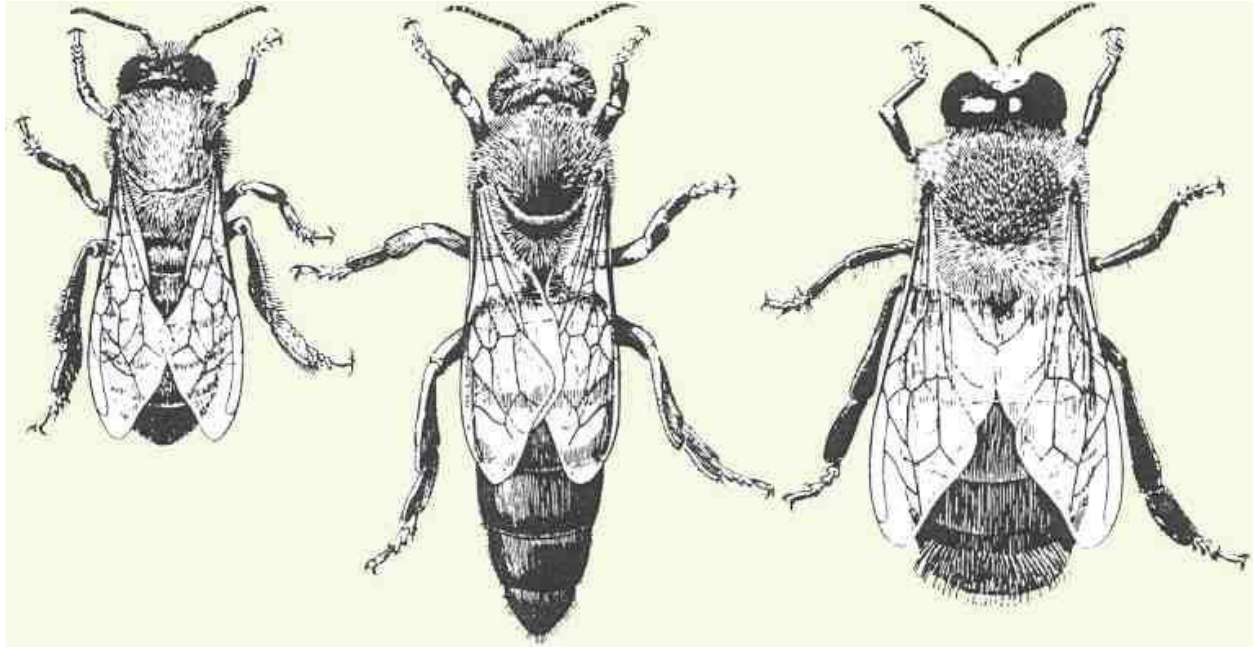

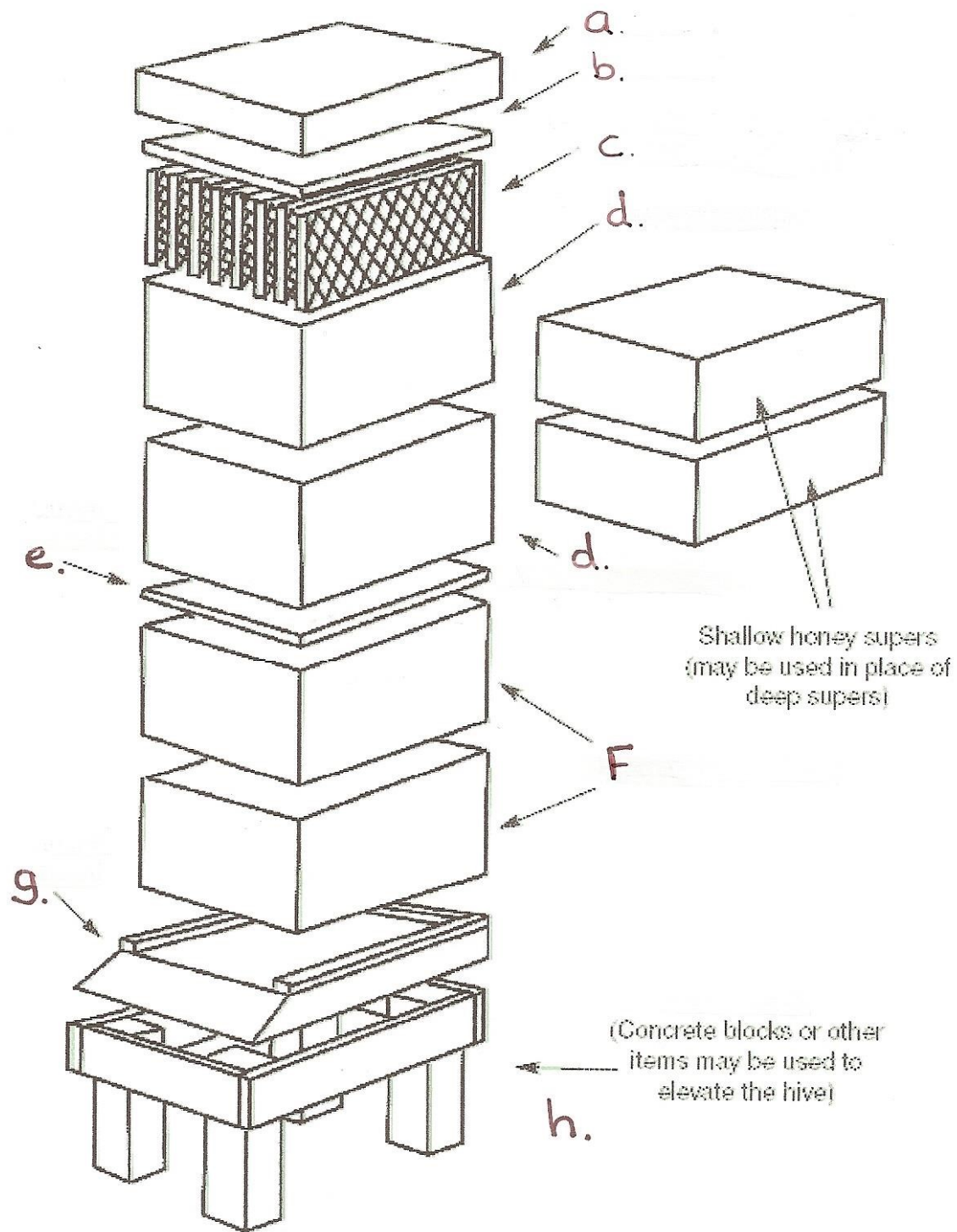
