Guidelines for Open Fine Arts

1. No more than three entries may be made in this department.
2. Size must be reasonable.
3. No re-exhibition of projects.
4. All exhibits may not consist of more than one article or piece unless permanently attached or affixed.
5. If the work was original (not from a kit) please make a note on your entry tag.
6. Drawings must be matted on a hard surface, framing will not be considered in the judging (Division 6504.)
7. **Do not put glass in frames.**

Class 01 - Ceramic item, exhibitor cleaned greenware

Class 02 - Ceramic item, exhibitor purchased bisque

Class 03 - Plaster item

Class 04 - Porcelain item, exhibitor cleaned greenware

Class 05 - Porcelain item, exhibitor purchased bisque

DIVISION 6502 – SCRAP & ECOLOGY ART

Class 20 - Scrap & Ecology

DIVISION 6503 – PAINTING

Class 30 - Painted shirt

Class 31 - Painted item, such as furniture

DIVISION 6504 – FINE ART

Class 40 - Painting- Acrylic/Tempra/Oil

Class 41 - Water Color

Class 42 - Charcoal drawing

Class 43 - Pencil drawing (#2 Pencil not recommended)

Class 44 - Ink drawing (ballpoint pen not recommended)
