Fair Exhibit Requirements

1. Open to all 4-H Clubs and individuals in the county.
2. Placement of display is on a first come, first serve basis. Entry Forms are due in the Fair Office by 8:00 am Monday and must clearly define the display's location on map provided.
3. Displays to be remain in place from 8 am on Monday through 8 am Sunday. Displays may be set up as early as Saturday prior to the fair, after 6 pm.
4. Award winners will be announced during Opening Ceremonies on Monday.
5. Exhibitor(s) are responsible for maintaining their display the week of fair.

Judging Criteria:

1. Display complementary to the location it is placed.
2. Flowers and plant containers must be fresh, healthy and complimentary to display and location.
3. Overall appearance of entry.

Division 7501-Interactive Display

These displays will provide an opportunity for fair visitors to interact with your display. For example: photo ops, seating areas etc.

Class 01-4-H club or group

Class 02-Individual

Division 7502-Non Interactive Display

These displays will complement an area of the fairgrounds. These are standing displays that are non-interactive to the public. For example: plants and flowering container gardens, displays made from "upcycled" or repurposed materials etc.
