- 3. Displays to be remain in place from 8 am on Monday through 8 am Sunday. Displays may be set up as early as Saturday prior to the fair, after 6 pm.
- 4. Award winners will be announced during Opening Ceremonies on Monday.
- 5. Exhibitor(s) are responsible for maintaining their display the week of fair.

### Judging Criteria:

- 1. Display complementary to the location it is placed.
- 2. Flowers and plant containers must be fresh, healthy and complimentary to display and location.
- 3. Overall appearance of entry.


## Division 7502-Non Interactive Display
