Beef, swine, sheep, veal, goats, turkeys, chickens, ducks, rabbits

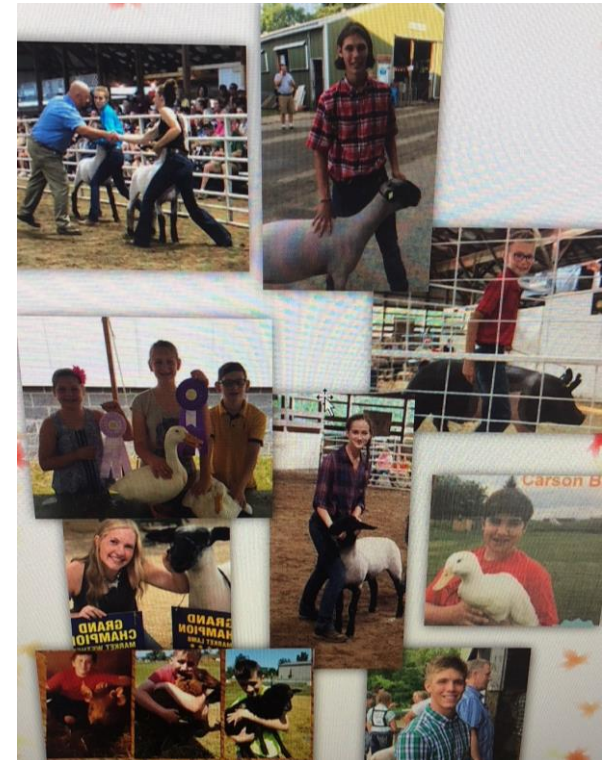

Option Three: send for resale

- Free shipping to livestock resale facility.
- You will receive a check for the resale amount.
- Tax deduction for the difference between your cost and the resale check
