### **Project Requirements**

1. Open to all 4-H clubs and individuals in the county.
2. Placement of display is on a first come, first serve basis.  
Entry forms are due in the Fair Office by 8:00 a.m. on Monday and must clearly define the display's location on map provided.
3. Displays to remain in place from 8:00 a.m. Monday through 10:00 p.m. on Saturday. Displays may be set up as early as Saturday prior to the fair, after 6 p.m.
4. Display must be safe for visitors and be able to withstand wind and rain.
5. Clubs must fill out an online entry form to receive Award.
6. Exhibitor(s) are responsible for maintaining their display the week of fair.

Judging Criteria:

1. Entry should enhance the visitors' experience at the location it is placed.
2. If using fresh flowers/plants they must be healthy and maintained during week of fair.
3. Overall appearance and durability of entry during the entire week of fair.

### **DIVISION 7501 – INTERACTIVE DISPLAY**

These displays will provide an opportunity for fair visitors to interact with your display. For example: Photo ops, seating areas, etc.

Class 01 – 4-H Club or group

Class 02 – Individual

### **DIVISION 7502 – NON-INTERACTIVE DISPLAY**

These displays will complement an area of the fairgrounds. These are standing displays that are non-interactive to the public. For example: plants and flowering container gardens, displays made from "upcycled" or repurposed materials, etc.
