Project Requirements

- 1. Neatness, creativity, age and year in project will be considered during judging.
- 2. Any subject is acceptable with any style of scrapbooking.
- 3. You may show your book again next year. The second year you must make the previous evaluation sheet part of your book and place it where your project ended. Judging will continue from that point. A minimum of 5 new pages.
- 4. Paper crafts projects should utilize various papers, tools and techniques to create unique hand-crafted greeting cards, gift tags or other projects.
- 5. Five gift tags should be shown; they can be related or different subjects. They should be displayed on 8 % x 11 heavy cardstock paper/poster board.
- 6. Three greeting cards should be shown; they can be related or different subjects. Envelopes are not needed.
- 7. Any paper craft that is not a greeting card, gift tag or scrap books may be entered in the other category, for example, bookmarks or postcards.
- 8. Clubs must sign up online as a club to receive a premium.
