Project Set Up: Friday at 6:30 p.m.

Premiums: A=\$4; B=\$2; C=No premiums.

Project Requirements:

1. Exhibitors must attend at least 70 percent of hive checks in their area, and fill in hive observation sheets for each visit.
2. Exhibitors may only exhibit one item in each class.
3. Exhibitors must keep honey from one hive separate in order to show in Classes 01-06.
4. Project book is due with observation sheets by July 1.
5. No honey or product will be shown from diseased hives.
6. Each entry will be labeled with an exhibit tag.

Division 2801 – Extracted Honey

Water content above 18.6% will be disqualified.

Honey must be from one hive (not mixed).

Honey must be bottled by exhibitor.

Honey should be submitted in 2 (1lb.) glass jars.

- Class 03** Amber Honey - 1-4 years in project

Division 2802 – Honey Comb/Spreads

Sections: 1 box or round section or cut comb

Creamed Honey: May use up to 20% purchased starter, 80% of the honey must be from managed hive

Chunk Honey: One cylindrical or square

Frame of Honey: One frame of capped honey, frame removal date should be noted in project book

- Class 10** Sections, 1-4 years in project
- Class 11** Sections, 5 or more years in project
- Class 12** Creamed Honey, 1-4 years in project
- Class 13** Creamed Honey, 5 or more years in project
- Class 14** Chunk Honey, 1-4 years in project

- Class 15** Chunk Honey, 5 or more years in project
- Class 16** Frame of Honey, 1-4 years in project
- Class 17** Frame of Honey, 5 or more years in project

Division 2803 – Beeswax

Beeswax Single Block: Same of 2 oz. must be from a single hive

Jar Candle: 1 beeswax candle in a glass jar

Taper Candles: 1 pair, poured or dipped, pure beeswax candles

Votive Candles: 1 pair molded pure beeswax candles

Novelty Beeswax: A single or coordinated set of any size or shape, pure beeswax

Novelty Candles: Single or set, any size or shape, pure beeswax, must have a wick, may be painted or decorated

- Class 21** Beeswax Single Block, 5 or more years in project
- Class 22** Jar Candle, 1-4 years in project
- Class 23** Jar Candle, 5 or more years in project
- Class 24** Taper Candles, 1-4 years in project
- Class 25** Taper Candles, 5 or more years in project
- Class 26** Votive Candles, 1-4 years in project
- Class 27** Votive Candles, 5 or more years in project
- Class 28** Novelty Beeswax, 1-4 years in project
- Class 29** Novelty Beeswax, 5 or more years in project
- Class 30** Novelty Candles, 1-4 years in project
- Class 31** Novelty Candles, 5 or more years in project

Division 2804 – Cosmetics

Hand Cream/Lotion: 1 jar 2-4 oz.

Soap Bars: 2 bars

Lip Balm: 2 jars, tins or tubes at least

- Class 36** Hand Cream/Lotion, 5 or more years in project
- Class 37** Soap Bars, 1-4 years in project
- Class 38** Soap Bars, 5 or more years in project
- Class 39** Lip Balm, 1-4 years in project
- Class 40** Lip Balm, 5 or more years in project

BEEKEEPING CONTINUED

Division 2805 – Prepared Food

Baked Good: Recipe must use at least 3 tablespoons of honey

Non-Cooked Food: Example, salad with honey in the dressing

Beverage: Non-alcoholic, recipe must have ½ tablespoon per 12 oz. serving

- Class 45** Baked Good, 1-4 years in project
- Class 46** Baked Good, 5 years or more in project
- Class 47** Non-Cooked Food, 1-4 years in project
- Class 48** Non-Cooked Food, 5 or more years in project
- Class 49** Beverage, 1-4 years in project
- Class 50** Beverage, 5 or more years in project

Division 2806 – Display

Photos: Must relate to beekeeping, can be close up, scenic or portrait. Must be a set of 5-8 photos. Must be mounted and labeled with date and type of camera.

Poster or Collage: Must have some aspect of beekeeping as its primary focus. No larger than 22"x28"

Entomology: Displayed or mounted bees. Consists of 3 worker bees and three drone bees mounted on pins, displayed suitable to hang. Label each bee's brand, coloration, date collected and size. Must be preserved and mounted for entomology display (wings should be spread)

Decorated Bee Hive: If hive is housing bees, pictures may be submitted showing all 4 sides of the hive. Decorations should not affect the functionality of the hive.
