### **Project Requirements:**

1. One exhibit per class.
2. It is recommended exhibitor should attend at least one of the several Hunting & Wildlife educational clinics that will be offered by 4-H starting in November.
3. Depicting an area of Michigan plant or animal information presented in one of three presentations:  
**Photo Journal** – 10 or more photos and narrative describing the photos.  
**Digital Presentation** – 3-5 minute presentation saved to flash drive.  
**Diorama** – Display presentation (3-D Exhibit) with narrative. (Example: A slideshow or photo journal of a walk along a Michigan stream; picture of the erosion of banks, the moss on fallen tree branch, etc., including a descriptive narrative.)
