The Pet Parade is open to all youth and will be held Saturday of the fair starting at 3 p.m. Pets cannot include animals already exhibited at the fair. Animals must be under control and paraded by carrying or leading around a ring. Age is determined on January 1st of the current year. Participation ribbons awarded, but no premiums paid. Class may be split or combined at the discretion of the Pet Parade Superintendents.

- Pet does not have to be owned by exhibitor.
- Pet can only be shown once.
- Child can only show once.
- No swine of any kind may enter the fairgrounds unless moved directly to a slaughter facility from the fairgrounds.
- All dogs must have their dog license tag on their collar.
- All pets must stay in designated area.
