Guidelines for Open (Adult) Fine Arts:

- 1. Size must be reasonable.
- 2. No re-exhibition of projects.
- 3. All exhibits may not consist of more than one article or piece unless permanently attached or affixed.
- 4. If the work was not original, meaning from a kit, make a note on your entry tag.
- 5. Drawings must be matted on a hard surface. Framing will not be considered in the judging (Division 6504).
- 6. Do not put glass in frames.
