

## **OPEN CLASS (ADULT) FINE ARTS**

### **Guidelines for Open (Adult) Fine Arts:**

1. Size must be reasonable.
2. No re-exhibition of projects.
3. All exhibits may not consist of more than one article or piece unless permanently attached or affixed.
4. If the work was not original, meaning from a kit, make a note on your entry tag.
5. Drawings must be matted on a hard surface. Framing will not be considered in the judging (Division 6504).
6. **Do not put glass in frames.**

- Class 01** Adult, ceramic item, exhibitor cleaned greenware  
**Class 02** Adult, ceramic item, exhibitor purchased bisque  
**Class 03** Adult, plaster item  
**Class 04** Adult, porcelain item, exh. cleaned greenware  
**Class 05** Adult, porcelain item, exh. Purchased bisque

### **Division 6502 – Adult Scrap & Ecology Art**

- Class 20** Adult, Scrap & Ecology

### **Division 6503 – Adult Painting**

- Class 30** Adult, Painted Shirt  
**Class 31** Adult, Painted item, such as furniture

### **Division 6504 – Adult Fine Art**

- Class 40** Adult, painting, acrylic/Tempra/oil  
**Class 41** Adult, water color  
**Class 42** Adult, charcoal drawing  
**Class 43** Adult, pencil drawing (#2 pencil not rec.)  
**Class 44** Adult, ink drawing (ballpoint not rec.)  
**Class 45** Adult, chalk/pastel drawing
