Record Book required of all exhibitors in order to show and must be turned into the Fair Office or 4-H Office by July 1. Books available at the Fair Office, Website or 4-H office.

Project Requirements:

- All cavies must be owned by the exhibitor by May 1 of the current year. For those cavies under the age of 69 days the sow kindling the litter must be owned by the exhibitor by May 1st of the current year.
- 2. Exhibitors must fit, show and take care of their own animals at fair.
- 3. Those exhibiting will be limited to two entries per class. Superintendent may need to limit total entries per exhibitor based on barn capacity.
- Cavy must have the required ear tag at the time of check in.
- 5. Cavy will be judged by A.R.B.A. standards.
- 6. No breeding of show cavies at Goodells County Park during fair.
- 7. Any cavy that is used as a showmanship cavy must be owned by the exhibitor and must be shown in their breed class unless okayed by the superintendent.
- 8. A Best of Breed ribbon will be awarded in each breed division if warranted by the judge.
- 9. A Best of Variety & Best Opposite Variety will be selected in each breed variety. From those variety winners a best and best opposite sex of breed will be chosen. A Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex of breed will be selected in each breed. These selections will determine which animal will represent their breed in the championship classes.
- All cavy exhibitors are responsible for set up and clean up fair week
- 11. Cavies must be removed from the barn at the conclusion of the show on Tuesday.
- 12. Barn duty is required for all exhibitors. Each is asked to sign up for a specific time during fair week on the board posted near the judging tables. A listing of what is expected of those on duty will be posted in the same location.

13. All cavies must meet the minimum weight requirements for their breed to be shown.
