- Record Book required of all exhibitors in order to show and must be turned into the Fair Office or 4-H Office by July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Incomplete or late books will not be eligible for Best In Class or higher awards. This is a part of your 4-H project.
- Project books will be judged and the top 10 scores from each age group will receive placing ribbons.

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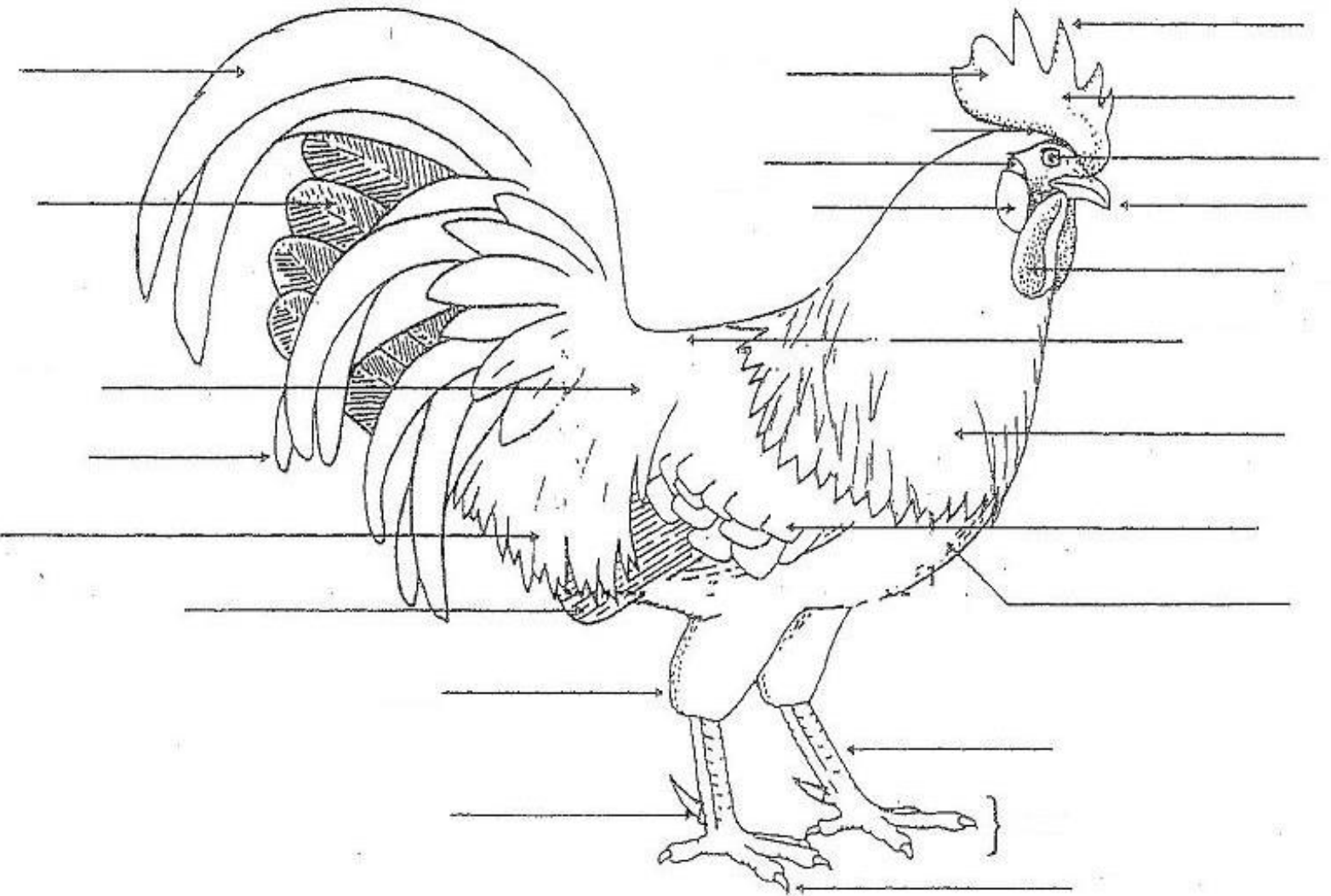
