Project Requirements:

1. Wool fleece is to be placed in an open, clear plastic bag. Llama, angora and mohair exhibited loose in an open clear plastic bag. No red plastic twine.
2. All fleece/wool must be from exhibitor's own animal and/or shown by exhibitor. Fiber for projects can be bought or gifted.
3. Full fleece must be shown to receive maximum credit. DO NOT include neck, head, stomach, leg or backend wool.
4. Llama and alpaca barrel fleece only.
5. Fleece must be dry to avoid felting. Fleeces must be skirted.
6. List all resources used for any information. This includes books, magazines, websites, newsletters, etc.
7. Interview required for all exhibits.
8. Exhibitors must display small, lightweight project in a way that keeps them secure and not able to be blown away.
