OPEN CLASS (ADULT) FOLK ARTS

Guidelines for Open (Adult) Folk Arts:

- 1. Size must be reasonable.
- 2. No re-exhibition of projects.
- 3. All exhibits may not consist of more than one article or piece unless permanently affixed or attached.
- 4. If the work was not original, meaning from a kit, make a note on the entry tag.
- 5. No item of value to be used.

<u>Division 6601 - Adult Felting & Fiber Art</u>

- Class 01 Adult, hand felted item from any fiber
 Class 02 Adult, machine felted item from any fiber
- Class 03 Adult, product of fiber

Division 6602 - Adult Holiday Decoration

Class 20	Adult, tree, small, handmade, no ceramic
Class 21	Adult, wreath
Class 22	Adult, centerpiece
Class 23	Adult, Christmas-type tree, any size, decorated
Class 24	Adult, Other

<u>Division 6603 – Adult Scarecrow</u>

Class 30 Adult, Scarecrow, one entry in this class All exhibits must be between 4 & 5 feet tall (from base to top including any headgear) and between 2-3 feet wide, at widest point, and must stand alone on its own base. Judged on creativity, uniqueness, attractiveness, good use of materials, and color. Scarecrows should not contain items of value.

Division 6604 - Adult Woodworking

Class 40	Adult, woodworking with finished surface
Class 41	Adult, woodworking, unfinished or rustic surface
Class 42	Adult, refinished furniture, indoor/outdoor
