- 3. All exhibits may not consist of more than one article or piece unless permanently attached or affixed.
- 4. If the work was from a kit, please make a note on your entry tag.
- 5. All clothing must be cleaned and pressed. It is recommended that sewers should not wear their garments prior to exhibition.
