Class 07 Inter. calf, born 12-1-24, but before 2-28-25

Class 08 Sr. Calf, born 9-1-24, but before 11-30-24

Class 09 Summer Yearling, born 6-1-24, but before 8-31-24

Class 10 Jr. Yearling, born 3-1-24, but before 5-31-24

Class 11 Inter. Yearling, born 12-1-22, but before 2-28-23

Class 12 Sr. Yearling, born 9-1-23, but before 11-30-23

Class 14 Jr. 2 yr. old cow, born 6-1-22, but before 8-31-22

Class 15 2 yr. old cow, born 9-1-21, but before 5-31-22

Class 16 3 yr. old cow, born 9-1-20, but before 8-31-21

Class 17 4 yr. old & over cow, born before 8-31-20

Class 20 Dairy Herd, 2 animals, a cow & her offspring

Class 21 Clover Sprout Dairy Breed (Exhibitor 5-7 yrs. old)

Class 22 Grand & Reserve Champion Holstein

Note: Senior yearlings in production will show in 2 yr. old class.

Class 32 Best Udder of Show

Grand & Reserve Champion Dairy from each Breed
