- 2. All fleece/wool must be from exhibitor's own animal and/or shown by exhibitor. Fiber for projects can be bought or gifted.
- Full raw fleece must be shown to receive maximum credit. DO NOT include neck, head, stomach, leg or backend wool.
- 4. Llama and alpaca barrel fleece only.
- 5. Fleece must be dry to avoid felting. Fleeces must be skirted, and raw.
- 6. List all resources used for any information. This includes books, magazines, websites, newsletters, etc.
- 7. Interview required for all exhibits.
- Exhibitors must display small, lightweight project in a way that keeps them secure and not able to be blown away.
